The Project

LIT is what I call a “lyrical remix” album. A **remix** is defined as “a variant of an original recording (as of a song) made by rearranging or adding to the original”. **Lyrics** are simply defined as “the words of a song”.

So what I’ve done with this project is taken mainstream pop and hip hop songs, kept the beat or instrumental in place, and then written my own original lyrical content. The theme of each song is also connected or inspired in some way by the original song.

The mainstream music of today is produced and engineered at such an incredible level that listeners can’t help but be struck and attracted by the beauty of its sound. However, one personal reflection I’ve had is that the message embedded within the lyrical content of a lot of mainstream music often leaves a lot to be desired.

And that’s where *LIT* comes in. I do my best to infuse a spiritually and socially conscious message into each remix, while maintaining the amazing sound and style of the original production.

The inspiration for this album was another project titled “*Wide Awake*”, by Karim Rushdy, a fellow rapper that I really admire. I reached out to him in the early stages of the project, and he expressed a lot of enthusiasm and encouragement. Through our conversations, I eventually hired him as the mixing engineer for the project, and he’s also featured on the opening track!

All of the songs on the album are also inspired by the Baha’i Writings, as I often study and meditate on various passages and quotations while I’m exploring song ideas and brainstorming lyrics. In fact, the following Baha’i quote was another inspiration for embarking on the project:

“Material civilization is like unto the lamp, while spiritual civilization is the light in that lamp. If the material and spiritual civilization become united, then we will have the light and the lamp together, and the outcome will be perfect.”

Connecting this quote to rapping and music, I view the technical components of the song creation, such as the instruments and rap flow, as the lamp. While the spirit and message of the song represent the light. I feel that so much of mainstream music is this exquisite and beautiful lamp, but the light seems to be lacking. My aim is to infuse light into the lamp. To make it... LIT!

About Me



I am a Baha'i, husband, father, rapper, film producer, and changemaker! My mission is music is to create socially and spiritually conscious hip hop that uplifts, educates, and inspires.

I am a fully independent artist, and I've released two previous albums without a record label. The first was titled "[Change the World](#)", which was a collaborative album with Cameroonian pop singer AWU. The goal of the album was to inspire humanity to do something positive to make a difference. The second project was my debut solo album, titled "[Wizdome](#)", which had the goal of infusing the Baha'i Writings into rap and hip hop.

I've also produced several music videos which have attained notoriety online, amassing a few hundred thousand views in total on YouTube and Facebook.

I also enjoy performing, touring, and hosting my own events. I've toured around the Southwest and West Coast of the United States, and performed locally, around the country, and around the world.
